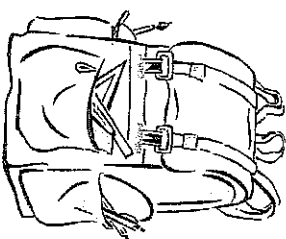
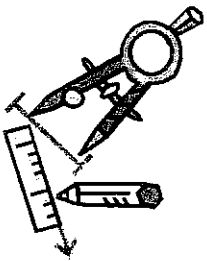


Our 2022 – 2023 theme "Rooted in Christ" is based on *Colossians 2:6-7*:

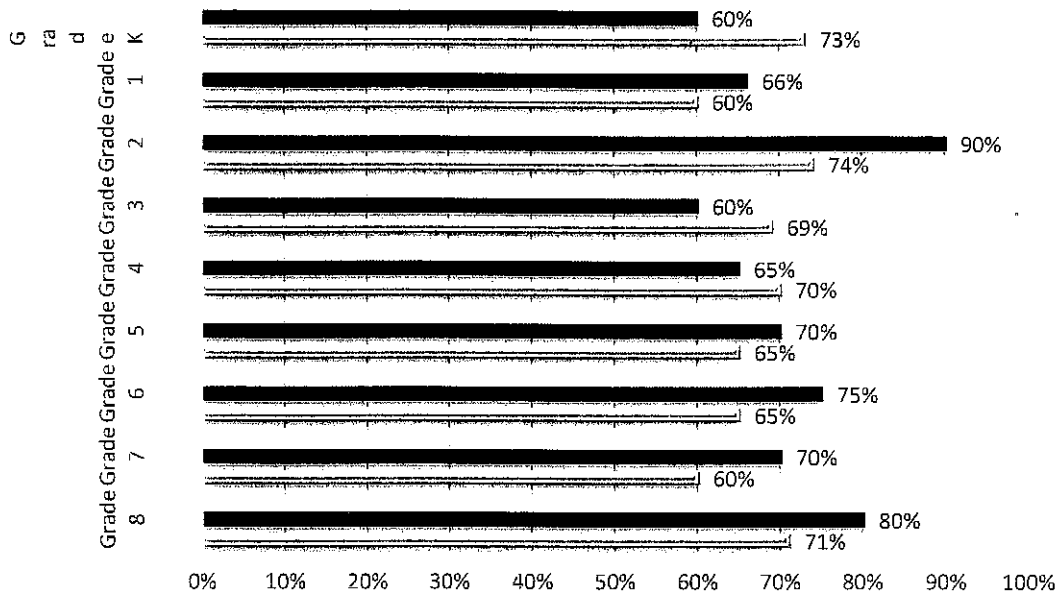

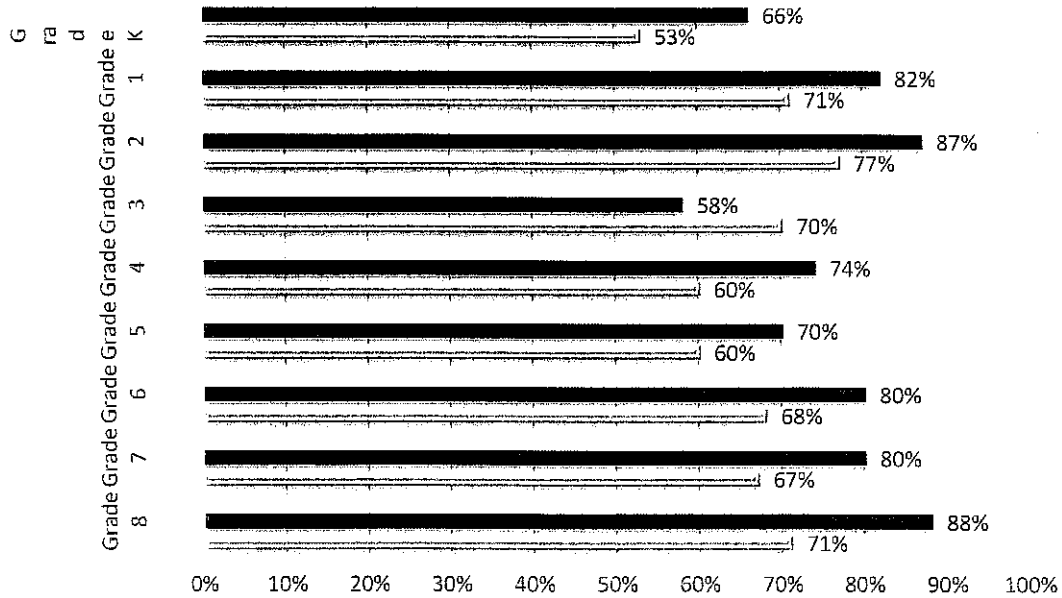
2021-2022 Terra Nova - Reading Results

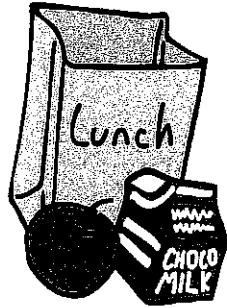


2021-2022 Terra Nova - Math Results

LUNCHROOM INFORMATION



Our computerized lunch system in Sycamore allows parents to make lump sum deposits to family accounts. Families will have the ability to check account status online to determine balance and view purchasing information for each child. Letters with login information and pins for new families will be sent home in a letter to the parents after school begins. The cost of full meals, milk, or a la carte items are then taken from the family account as purchased each day.

The cost for lunch options are as follows:

Lunch: \$4.25 each

Milk: \$.50 each

Snacks or extras of sides: \$.50

A La Carte or main entrée: \$2.25



You will receive an email reminder when your family account balance is below \$5.00.

Payments (check or cash) can be sent in to the school office anytime and may take a day or two to be posted. You may also call and request a bank draft for lunchroom fees.

UNIFORM DRESS CODE

At Our Savior Lutheran the uniform is a reflection of our attitude. Our dress code is designed to encourage modesty within a community that values character and compassion.

General Uniform Guidelines

- Shirts ALWAYS tucked in
- Slacks/shorts with loops require a belt.
- Socks need to be visible above the shoes.
- Slacks / shorts CANNOT BE “cargo” or “jean” style.
- Shoes should be either leather or athletic with non-marking soles and closed toe. No boots or crocks style.
- Girls may wear non-visible modesty shorts under their jumper or skirt.
- “Spirit Wear” cannot be worn in place of school uniform items.
- All hair styles need to be neat, clean, out of their eyes, and natural color.
- Facial hair on young men is not permitted.
- Embroidered tops are available online at lousportinggoods.com

Uniform Items

Shorts: Khaki or Navy, 1” above the knee

Slacks: Khaki or Navy

Belts: Brown, or Black

Turtleneck: Navy, Maroon, White

Polo Shirt: Navy, Maroon, White, long or short sleeved (embroidered available)

Shirt: White long or short sleeved oxford cloth with button down collar - worn by boys

Blouse: White, long or short sleeved, round collar - worn by girls

Sweatshirt: Navy, Maroon or Gray embroidered with Our Savior Lutheran School Logo (crewneck spirit wear sweatshirt is allowed)

Sweater: Navy, Maroon or White cardigan or crewneck pullover

Skorts: Khaki or Navy, no shorter than 1” above the knee - worn by girls grades K-8

Tights/Leggings: White, Gray, or Black, full length no capri length

Jumper: Maroon & Gray Plaid, no shorter than 1” above the knee - worn by girls grades K - 4

Skirt: Maroon & Gray Plaid, no shorter than 1” above the knee - worn by girls grades K - 8

Socks: White, Gray or Black - solid color only

NON-UNIFORM DAY GUIDELINES :

On special non-uniform days, students may dress according to the guidelines of the day as announced by the principal. Students not participating must be in regular school uniform attire

- All shirts/blouses are to have sleeves
- Bottoms will be Solid color, full length **BLUE** jeans (with no holes or fraying) OR Uniform Shorts **ONLY**.
- No leggings or sweatpants

SPIRIT DAY GUIDELINES

The **FIRST MONDAY** of each month will be “Spirit Day”. Students may wear school spirit wear tops purchased **ONLY** online from Louisville Sporting Goods at lousportinggoods.com with the appropriate bottoms (see above). These items will be identified as “SPIRIT WEAR” on the website and orders could take up to 14 days to turn around.

Louisville Sporting Goods is our Spirit Wear Company. Spirit Wear is optional and can be worn on special designated days (Generally 1st MONDAYS). Parents order for yourself also, to wear at school events, games etc...

- Please check with Louisville Sporting Goods directly on delivery and timing. Items will likely take a few weeks to be ready.

CARPOOL GUIDELINES

For the safety of our school children and other adults on campus, and to improve the flow of the carpool drop-off and pick-up lines, please observe the following guidelines:

1. **Always** enter the school property at the church driveway (the 2nd entrance if coming from Lyndon Ln.), even if you plan to park. Consider it a **one-way** school drive. **Unloading** of students is to be at the triple front doors on the circle drive. **Loading** is to happen at the back EAST door across from soccer field.
2. Maintain a safe speed. **Slow Down!!!** You are in a school zone where children often act quickly and without thinking.
3. Pull your car up to the farthest available space. **If the car in front of you moves, follow it even if your rider has to walk back to you.** This will keep the line flowing. The children have been instructed to wait until you come to a stop in the farthest empty space. This applies also to morning drop-off. The fewer gaps in the line, the quicker everyone gets in and out of the building.
4. Praise your rider for being responsible when they hear their number and come out promptly! If they don't come out immediately, please pull around and come through the carpool line again or park off to side lot facing the soccer field. Please do not get out of your car.
5. If possible, we encourage your rider to **enter and exit the vehicle on the passenger side only.**
6. If your rider needs to return to the building for some reason, please park your car in the lot near the soccer field. Please do not park at the side door. That area is needed for cars waiting for children to exit.
7. **Please display your number at all times.** We can't emphasize this enough. It is a beneficial safety measure for your children. We want to release your children to the proper person. If a different person than usual is picking up your rider, please contact the school office.
8. **Please do not pass.** Patiently wait for the car in front of you to proceed or wait for school personnel to wave you past.

Reach Alert System

With Reach Alert, we can immediately advise you of breaking, time sensitive information. If it is snowing and classes are canceled, we will send an alert to your cell phone, home phone, or e-mail within seconds. If there is an emergency at school (power-outage, broken water line, or lock down), we can communicate with you and keep everyone informed.

**You decide how you want to receive our alerts:
Cell phone text message, voice call, and/or e-mail.
All you need to do is:**

1. Go to www.reachalert.com to register for the service.
2. Click on MY ACCOUNT (orange box on left) and then CREATE AN ACCOUNT.
3. Follow the prompts and enter your contact information so that you will receive alerts via your preferred method (text message, voice call, or e-mail).
4. Enter Our Savior Lutheran School when asked which network you want to join. Just click on our name when it appears in the drop-down list.
5. Select Parent, you will be asked to enter your child's name. Each person registering will then need to enter **our registration code: 40222**.

If you request cell phone text messages, within seconds, Reach Alert will send your phone a text message with a four digit validation code. Reach Alert is making sure your text message will be successfully delivered. When you receive the four digit number, simply enter this number on the registration screen and then click on the word VALIDATE. If you do not receive the validation text, please call customer support at the number listed below. If you request voice calls, your number is immediately self-validated. The process is very simple.

If you do not have access to a computer or you have questions, please call Reach Alert toll free at (877)-307-9313. They will complete your registration in less than one minute.

We will use the system for timely, though not necessarily, emergency messages. We may remind you that tomorrow is picture day, conference day, or about a field trip. We may remind you of important meetings or other school activities. If we release students early, we can send a note to you.

K - 8 Childcare Services

Our Savior runs both before and after school childcare services for students in kindergarten through grade 8. These services are staffed by competent adults who meet state requirements and operate under the direction of the director and the principal. Additional fees are charged depending upon the number of days each week a student uses the service.

Before School Care

- Hours: 7:00 am - 8:00 am only on days that school is in session.
- Fees: **\$3.00** per day per child attending.
- No breakfast is included, but students may bring their own and eat in the designated area.
- Presently meets in the gymnasium.
- No paperwork is required to attend before school care.
- Fees are billed at the end of every month.

After School Care

- Hours: 3:30 pm - 6:00 pm on regular full school days.
11:45 am - 6:00 pm on early dismissal days.
- Specific paperwork must be completed each year before a student can use this service. Necessary forms are available from the school office.
- Fees vary depending on how many days in a week your child will be attending.
- Late fees of \$1.00 per minute apply to late pickups beginning at 6:00 pm.

After School Activities

- A snack is served daily to all students in attendance at no extra cost.
- Time is set aside and help is given to students who have homework to do.
- A variety of games, crafts, and activities are available for children throughout the afternoon.
- When weather permits, students spend a portion of time in outdoor play activities.
- After school activities often include use the gymnasium for large muscle activity.

Late Pickup Room

- For parents that are only running a few minutes late, children are cared for in the **SAME AREA AS AFTER SCHOOL CARE** at a cost of \$1.00 per minute. After 15 minutes students are assumed to be part of after school care.

Early Dismissal Special Events

- No lunch is provided. You will need to bring your own lunch including a drink, but an afternoon snack is included on these days.

State of Kentucky

Medical Certificate Requirements

Our Savior Lutheran School complies with all medical requirements as specified by Kentucky State Law. To attend school the following proofs of compliance are required before the start of the school year:

Preschool

1. Kentucky Immunization Certificate, including Hepatitis A & B Series. This is due within 2 weeks after the first day of attendance.
2. Kentucky Physical completed and dated no earlier than one year prior to or sixty days after the first day of attendance. **(Doctor's office has the forms required)**
3. Official Birth Certificate from the Department of Vital Statistics **(Copy) - (NOT the one from the hospital.)**
4. Kentucky Vision Examination for ages 3, 4, 5 & 6 and must be completed by an optometrist or ophthalmologist. **(One time only when first entering school.)**

Kindergarten - 5th grade

1. Kentucky Immunization Certificate, including two doses of MMR Vaccine and three doses of the Hepatitis B and 2 of the Hepatitis A series. This is due within 2 weeks after the first day of attendance.
2. Kentucky Kindergarten Physical completed and dated no earlier than one year prior to or sixty days after the first day of attendance. **(Doctor's office has the forms required) (only 1 form is required from Kindergarten through Grade 5 if not expired)**
3. Official Birth Certificate from the Department of Vital Statistics **(Copy) - (NOT the one from the hospital.)**
4. Kentucky Vision Examination for ages 3, 4, 5 & 6 and must be completed by an optometrist or ophthalmologist. **(One time only when first entering school.)**
5. Kentucky Dental Screening - Only for ages 5, 6. Your Dentist should have the forms in their office. (Copies available in the school office if needed.)

6th Grade - 8th Grade

1. Kentucky Immunization Certificate indicating two doses of MMR Vaccine and three doses of the Hepatitis B and 2 of the Hepatitis A series. This is due within 2 weeks after the first day of attendance.
2. Kentucky 6th grade physical completed and dated no earlier than one year prior to or sixty days after the first day of attendance. **(only 1 form is required from 6th - 8th grade if not expired)**
3. Official Birth Certificate from the Department of Vital Statistics **(Copy) - (NOT the one from the hospital.)**

Please note that Kentucky State Law specifies for an *Immunization Certificate* to be valid it must be:

- A Kentucky certificate
- Have dates of immunizations filled in
- Must have current dates and not be expired
- MUST be signed and dated by required personnel

Please note that Kentucky State Law specifies for a *Physical Certificate* to be valid it must be:

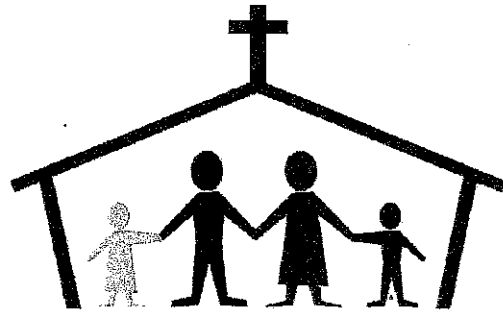
- A Kentucky form
- Filled out completely including being signed and dated by the physician's office

- ONLY 1 COPY OF A BIRTH CERTIFICATE IS REQUIRED
- ONLY 1 EYE EXAM FOR CHILDREN AGES 3, 4, 5, OR 6 IS REQUIRED
- IF CURRENT IMMUNIZATION CERTIFICATE IS NOT EXPIRED, NO NEED TO SEND ANOTHER ONE
- ONLY 1 PHYSICAL FOR GRADES K-5 IS REQUIRED
- ANY STUDENT ENTERING 6TH GRADE WILL NEED A 6TH GRADE (NEW) PHYSICAL

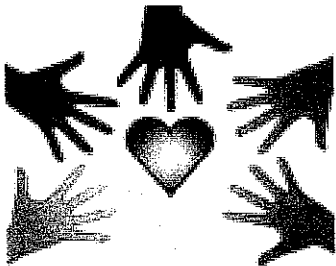
